1. Objective

This reference categorization table shows the concept of test categories, product examples, and reference examples of test categories in order to assure the maximum possible level of consistency among member companies and among products in performing the **durability** test defined in Terms 4, 5, 6, and 7: “Voluntary Specifications for Quality and Safety” of the Rules and Detailed Rules of this society.

Definition of **durability** test

“**Durability** test” as used in this guideline refers to a series of tests for **treating the products conferred with antibacterial, antifungal, and antiviral functions, etc. under preset conditions considering the environment where such products are normally used before testing their functions**, and does not assure functional **durability** during actual use and product lifetime.

2. Points of Note in Operation

- 1) **The durability** test is positioned as preparation for evaluating the antibacterial, antifungal, or antiviral activity which is necessary to register a product with SIAA.
- 2) The reference categorization table shows product examples and test categories from the point of view of customers, in order to supplement the content (range) of application of the categories of waterproofing test [Table 1] and light resistance test [Table 2].
- 3) The test categories are the guidelines for test conditions stipulated voluntarily by this society, and the content of this reference categorization table is not absolute.
- 4) As products are used in various ways, the application category may differ depending on the usage environment and portion even in the case of an identical product.
- 5) The test categories are defined under the responsibility of the company that registers the product and can grasp the actual condition of the product used. Additionally, the categories described in “Voluntary Registration Data Sheets Concerning Quality and Safety” shall be the same as the test conditions implemented.
- 6) The content of this guideline may be reviewed and amended as needed.
- 7) This guideline does not restrict the specifications (standards) of the industrial associations and institutions to which the member companies belong.

3. **Durability** Test (For details of test conditions, refer to test methods S08 and S09.)

Waterproofing test and light resistance test are set as **durability** tests.

4-1. Categories of Waterproofing Test

Assuming that the surface of a product conferred with antibacterial, antifungal, or antiviral function loses its functionality and performance becomes deteriorated when in contact with water (or warm water), a test according to the performance of the product (antibacterial, antifungal, or antiviral test) shall be implemented after treating a test piece under the test conditions (water temperature and immersion time) specified for waterproofing test categories.

Waterproofing test is classified into four categories, considering the degree of contact of the product with water (Table 1).

Table 1 Categories of as well as temperature and immersion time for waterproofing test

Category	Immersion conditions		Applicability (Range)

0	Not performed		Products that do not come into contact with water (Products that do not come into contact with water in ordinary use settings, or come into contact with water only during cleaning, etc.)
1	Normal temperature ²	16 - 18	Products that are unlikely to come into contact with water (Products that do not come into contact with water except for incidental splashing)
2	50 +/- 5	16 - 18	Products that often come into contact with water (Products for containing water or for use in water)
3	50 +/- 5	16 - 18	Products that often come into contact with warm water (Products for containing warm water or for use in warm water)

4-2. Categories of Light Resistance Test

Light resistance test, in which a test according to the performance of the product (antibacterial, antifungal, or antiviral test) is implemented after treating a test piece under the test conditions (testing device and irradiation time) specified for light resistance test categories, based on the assumption that the performance of a product conferred with antibacterial, antifungal, or antiviral function becomes deteriorated when it is exposed to light (in particular, ultraviolet ray), is classified into three categories considering the exposure of the product to light (Table 2).
